

# Privacy Statement Octopus Protocol

## Introduction

1. Octopus Protocol attaches great importance to the responsible handling of personal data of users of its website (hereafter "Users").
2. In this Privacy Statement, Octopus Protocol informs Users about the way Octopus Protocol processes their personal data and how they can control this process.

## **Article 1: Explanation of personal data and goal for the processing thereof**

### Personal data

1. Octopus Protocol collects email addresses and names (hereafter "Personal Data") of individuals who decide to sign up for the Octopus Protocol Newsletter. These are data that can be linked to the identity of an individual person.
2. Octopus Protocol is at all times responsible for the management of the Personal Data provided by each User and will make every effort to protect these Personal Data. In the event of a data breach, Octopus Protocol will immediately inform the User of that event via the email address known to it and make every effort to prevent further distribution of these Personal Data.
3. The User has the right at all times to receive the Personal Data provided by him / her to Octopus Protocol in an orderly manner from Octopus Protocol ("right of access"). On the first request of a User, Octopus Protocol will forward his / her Personal Data to a third party to be designated by that User ("right to data portability") or remove it entirely from its system ("right to be forgotten").
4. Any questions that a User may have regarding his Personal Data can be asked to [users@octopus.exchange](mailto:users@octopus.exchange). These questions will be answered within 2 working days at the latest.

### **Goal**

5. Octopus Protocol requires Personal Data from a User to send him or her informational emails for which that User signed up.

## **Permission**

6. To receive, process and use Personal Data of a User, Octopus Protocol requires the User's permission. This permission is granted by a User by agreeing to provide his Personal Information in order to receive informational emails.

## **Article 2: Transfer to third parties**

1. Octopus Protocol does not give Personal Data of Users to third parties.

## **Article 3: Data security**

1. Octopus Protocol makes use of appropriate technical and organizational security procedures, among other things to ensure that unauthorized persons do not gain access to Personal Data and to prevent the loss, unlawful use, or modification of Personal Data.

## **Article 4: Availability and modification of your data**

1. Users can request access to their Personal Data at any time. Users may also request that their Personal Data be changed or deleted by sending an e-mail to [users@octopus.exchange](mailto:users@octopus.exchange).
